PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61342 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David John Stout, Sr. of PO Box 266, Langlois, Oregon 97450, phone 348-2541, for the use of the waters of Jim Creek, a tributary of Floras Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.005 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 3, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 700 feet North and 1,100 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 31 South Range 15 West, WM Section 11 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for two families and 10.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
