PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61796 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank M. and Mary M. Nesbit of 885 West 18th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon 97402, phone 344-7715, for the use of the waters of Metolius River, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 15, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 595 feet North and 860 feet West from the quarter corner between Sections 14 and 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 13 South Renge 9 East, WM Section 15 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
