PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61825 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lloyd H. Ross of Star Route, Box 61, Chiloquin, Oregon 97624, phone 783-2408, for the use of the waters of Upper Klamath Lake, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 23, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5.78 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,300 feet South and 2,775 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed three acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
