PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61839 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kathleen Kelley of Star Route 2, Box 16-B, Days Creek, Oregon 97429, phone 825-3666, for the use of the waters of Days Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 26, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 690 feet North and 150 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 1, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 30 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South Range 4 West, WM Section I SE 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for one family including one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
