PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61869 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David White of Route 2, Box 241, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 473-3329, for the use of the waters of a series of springs, tributaries of Willow Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 8, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 17 feet North and 810 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23; Diversion 2 - 241 feet North and 1,254 feet East from the Southeast Corner of WS NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23; Diversion 3 - 16 feet North and 14 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, all being within Township 17 South, Range 44 East, WM, in the County of Maineur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for the lands described as supplemental shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
