PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61926 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tom Kahoun of 5250 Upper Applegate, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-7848, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 20, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet South and 610 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 22, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South Range 3 West, WM Section 22 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
