PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61933 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Richard Edmunson of Box 164, Drewsey, Oregon 97904, phone 493-2607, for the use of the waters of a spring and Cottonwood Creek, being 0.25 cubic foot of water per second from the spring and 1.51 cfs from Cottonwood Creek, tributaries of Malheur River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 20, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.76 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: spring - 50 feet South and 75 feet East from the Southeast Corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, WM, and Cottonwood Creek - 200 feet North and 165 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 5, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Harney.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed three acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
