PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61938 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Nelson H. Pederson of 557 Joseph Court, SE, Salem, Oregon 97302, phone 588-2699, for the use of the waters of an unnamed branch of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 21, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet North and 175 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South Range 14 West, WM Section 16 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
