## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61939 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Donald W. Mantie of 9700 Sunnyview Road, NE, Salem, Oregon 97301, phone 364-3021, for the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Williamette River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 22, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,530 feet South and 290 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 24, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 7 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South Range I West, WM Section 19 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 21.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 12.7 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 12.7 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation the right allowed may, in the interest on conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
