PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63111 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Hans Raotke of PO Box 244, Yachats, Oregon 97498, phone 547-3812, for the use of the waters of Indian Creek, a tributary of Lake Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for 18 families, commercial use in a bar-cafe and irrigation, being 0.02 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use, 0.01 cfs for commercial use and 0.10 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 11, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 900 feet South and 250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South Range 9 West, WM Section 20 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.5 acres irrigation,
1 Bar-Cafe commercial
use and 14 domestic
residential uses

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 15.5 acres irrigation and 4 domestic residential uses

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
