PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60328 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Cheries Henning Petersen of 7120 Northeast 63rd Avenue, Vancouver, Washington 98661, for the use of the waters of Jumpoff Joe Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.004 cfs for irrigation use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 8, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.009 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 600 feet South and 235 feet East from the Northwest Corner of NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 35 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South Range 6 West, WM Section 20 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family and irrigation of one-third acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed four and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
