PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60483 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Parks and Open Space Division, Lane County of 125 East 8th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon 97401, phone 687-4231, for the use of the waters of Coast Fork Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of dust controls that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 11, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,775 feet North and 660 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South Range 3 West, WM Section 12 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Dust control of horse arena and surrounding grounds

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
