### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60486 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edward J. Cooley of PO Box 642, Elkton, Oregon 97436, phone 584-2693, for the use of the waters of Mehl Creek and an unnamed stream, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families, irrigation and supplemental irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from the unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in supply at the unnamed stream to be made up by diversion of water from Mehl Creek for domestic use for two families, 0.11 cfs from Mehl Creek when available with any deficiency in supply at Mehl Creek to be made up by diversion of water from the unnamed stream for irrigation of 8.6 acres, and 0.02 cfs from the unnamed stream for the supplemental irrigation of 1.4 acres; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 12, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Mehl Creek) - 560 feet South and 900 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 13; and Diversion 2 (unnamed stream) - 1,240 feet South and 600 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 13, both being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 23 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 23 South Range 8 West, WM Section 13 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for two families, irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
