PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60915 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

This permit is issued to Susan L.V. Long and Thomas D. Long of PO Box 4024, Eastside, Oregon 97420, phone 269-2783, for the use of the waters of a spring, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.0125 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 16, 1980 for 0.013 cfs and December 8, 1981 for 0.0045 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0175 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,045 feet North and 700 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 4, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South Range 12 West, WM Section 4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family and 1.0 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
