PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61991 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elden Snyder of 16805 Highway 238, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6496, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Lake Reservoir, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 30, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second from the Applegate River for irrigation measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, and 20.0 acre-feet stored water only from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810 for supplemental irrigation.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,050 feet South and 500 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM; and Applegate Lake Reservoir is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, both in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed four and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0376 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
