## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63115 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Laddle Polanek of 2625 Southwest Sherwood Drive, Portland, Oregon 97201, phone 223-3671, for the use of the waters of Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and stock use, being 0.13 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 250 feet South and 1,000 feet East from the Common Corner of Sections 34, 27, 28, and 33, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 North Range 6 West, WM Section 34 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 acres irrigation NE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.0 acres irrigation and stock use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1. 1984.
