## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62361 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Malcolm Trowbridge of PO Box 435, Newberg, Oregon 97132, phone 538-3015, for the use of the waters of Williamson Creek and spring area, being 0.025 cubic foot of water per second from the spring area with any deficiency in supply at the spring area to be supplied by Williamson Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 18, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: <u>Creek - 480</u> feet North and 1,560 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14 and <u>spring area - 470</u> feet North and 1,570 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, both being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South Range 3 West, WM Section 14 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
