PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62901 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert M. Metcalf of 1334 NW Washington Blvd., Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-6928, for the use of the waters of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 25, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 750 feet South and 100 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 30 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South Range 3 East, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
