PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61834 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond E. Monroe of Route 2, Box 328, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 473-2174, for the use of the waters of a drain ditch, a tributary of Willow Creek, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 24, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 620 feet North and 1,120 feet West from the Southwest Quarter Corner of Section 17, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South Range 45 East, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 14.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
