PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61842 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George R. and Joyce E. O'Day of 218 North Myrtle Route, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-4971, for the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek and spring, tributaries of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for two families, being 0.03 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation from Myrtle Creek and 0.01 cfs for domestic use from the spring; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 18, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: North Myrtle Creek - 245 feet South and 530 feet East and spring - 615 feet South and 210 feet East, both being from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 5, both being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
