PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62114 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Don D. and Gloria Jean Sutphin of 1809 Chinchalla Way, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 884-7956, for the use of the waters of Spring Creek, a tributary of Williamson River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 4, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 285 feet North and 282 feet East from the Center Corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 34 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South	Range 7 East, WM	Section 4	NE 1/4	SE 1/4	Domestic use for one family including one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
