### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62124 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Alvin and Maggie Brown of Route 1, Box 938, Dayville, Oregon 97825, phone 987-2907, for the use of the waters of John Day River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation, being 0.36 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation and 1.03 cfs for supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 5, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.39 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 160 feet North and 1,020 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 27, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
