PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60113 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Geraldine A. Williams of 435 Glenlyn Drive, Williams, OR 97544, phone 846-6417, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Camp Meeting Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 12, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3 feet North and 265 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 10, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 5 West, WM Section 10 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
