PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61173 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Silver Lake Irrigation District - ZX Ranch, c/o Lawrence Iverson of Silver Lake, OR 97638, phone 576-2217 or 576-2115, for the use of the waters of Thompson Valley Reservoir constructed under Permits R-680 and R-4461, a tributary of Silver Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 21, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which shall be available to beneficial use and shall not exceed 120 acre-feet stored water.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCA 1,700 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 17, being w/ Section 17, Township 30 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of

A description of the PLACE OF USE under such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South Range 14 East, WM Section 27 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 29.1 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 10.9 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of 3.0 acre-feet or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from Thompson Valley Reservoir constructed under Permits R-680 and R-4461.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
