PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61304 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arlene L. Kovash of 11425 Pedee Creek Road, Monmouth, OR 97361, phone 838-3512, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Pedee Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, stock, and domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, being 0.39 cubic foot per second from Pedee Creek for irrigation, 0.01 cfs for stock use, and 0.01 cfs for domestic use for two families from the unnamed stream; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 3, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.41 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (unnamed stream) - 85 feet South and 20 feet West from the Northwest Corner of DLC 51, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 2 (unnamed stream) - 100 feet South and 160 feet East from the Northwest Corner of DLC 51, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 3 (Pedee Creek) - 350 feet South and 2,100 feet East from the Northwest Corner of DLC 51, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, all from Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
