PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS "CERTIFICATE NO. 60517"

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62178 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Josephine J. Jensen of Rural Route 1, Box 106, Haines, OR 97833, phone 856-3550, for the use of the waters of waste water, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 4, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 180 feet South and 2,030 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
