PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62190 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Russell R. and/or Genevieve O. Mee of 310 Ridgewood Drive, Jacksonville, OR 97530, phone 899-1342, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 10, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 66.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 380 feet North and 510 feet West from the Interior "L" Corner, LaClair DLC 38, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM, and Applegate Dam being within the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0349 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
