PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61144 and do hereby grent the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Leo J. and Dorothy M. Gysin of PO Box 485, Fort Klamath, Oregon 97626, phone 381-2275, for the use of the waters of Anna Creek and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-61143, Permit R-8342, a tributary of Wood River, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of reservoir for fish culture; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 13, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.134 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 320 feet North and 315 feet East from the Northwest Corner of SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 32 South, Range 7 1/2 East; Diversion 2 - 105 feet North and 310 feet East from the Southwest Corner of SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 32 South, Range 7 1/2 East; Diversion 3 - 325 feet South and 260 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Lot 3, being within Lot 3 of Section 6, Township 33 South, Range 7 1/2 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South Range 7 1/2 East, WM Section 6 Lot 3 Fish culture

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 12, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1,1985.
