PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61763 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Milton O. Brown and Raymond J. Kittleson of 301 NW Murray Road, Portland, Oregon 97229, phone 643-5756, for the use of the waters of Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use in recreational campground and recreation, being 0.04 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.01 cfs for recreation (use in swimming pool); that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 24, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 230 feet North and 1,100 feet East from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
