PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62256 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Idaho Power Company of 1220 Idaho Street, PO Box 70, Boise, Idaho 83707, phone (208) 383-2200, for the use of the waters of the Snake River, a tributary of the Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of fish trapping and propagation purposes; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 13, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 130.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 5,494.5 feet North and 19,840.2 feet East from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within Lot 6 of Section 4, Township 4 South, Range 49 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South Range 49 East, WM Section 4 Lot 6 Fish trapping and propagation purposes

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 12, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
