## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63049 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mitchell and Nelson Associates, Inc., agent for Michelbook Estates, Inc. of 1420 SW Broadway, Portland, Oregon 97201, phone 225-0822, for the use of the waters of North Branch of Cozine Creek and North and South Reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-63048, Permit R-8344, tributaries of South Yamhill River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 17, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.56 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (North Lake) - 800 feet North and 1,030 feet East; Diversion 2 (South Lake) - 600 feet North and 1,200 feet East; both being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 4 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit R-8344, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 12, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
