PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 59796 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of 74 South Alvord, Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 573-2071, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of animal drinking water; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 19, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.0 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,980 feet South and 2,240 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South Range 26 East, WM Section 7 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 animal drinking
water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
