PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 59898 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, of 19559 Southeast Division Street, Gresham, Oregon 97030, phone 667-0511, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Tilly Jane Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and commercial use for day lodge facility, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.05 cfs for commercial use; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from March 20, 1980 for domestic use and September 9, 1980 for commercial use, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.055 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,590 feet South and 775 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South Range 9 East, WM Section 12 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family and commercial use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
