PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60604 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David and JoAnn Winters of Sitkum Route, Box 123-AB, Myrtle Point, Oregon 97458, phone 572-5542, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams and East Fork Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second from Unnamed Stream 1 for domestic use, 0.019 cfs from Unnamed Stream 2 for irrigation and 0.031 cfs from East Fork Coquille River for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 9, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Unnamed Stream 1 - 270 feet North and 1,665 feet East; Unnamed Stream 2 - 70 feet North and 1,420 feet East and East Fork Coquille River - 760 feet North and 1,635 feet East, all from the Southwest Corner SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, all being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 28 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South Range 10 West, WM Section 6 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family and irrigation of 4.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
