## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61198 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Highcroft Orchards by David B. Lowry, Partner of 623 South Grape Street, PO Box 4429, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 772-2563, for the use of the waters of Highcroft Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-61197, Permit R-8350, a tributary of Bear Creek, for the PURPOSE of temperature control; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 16, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 7.5 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,780 feet South and 390 feet West from the Center of Section 22, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
