**PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS**

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61417 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Michael L. Farkas of 21100 Haskin Mill Road, Colton, Oregon 97017, phone 824-2339, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and two reservoirs constructed under Applications R-61416, Permit R-8360, and Application R-61619, Permit R-8363, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 19, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: unnamed stream - 800 feet South and 200 feet East; Reservoir 1 - 800 feet South and 200 feet East; and Reservoir 2 - 600 feet South and 150 feet East, all from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 5 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
