PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61513 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, of 19559 SE Division Street, Portland, Oregon 97030, phone 667-0511, for the use of the waters of John's Spring, a tributary of North Fork Mill Creek, for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife water; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 8, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,640 feet west from the quarter corner common to Sections 7 and 8, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 1 South, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South Range 11 East, WM Section 7 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Livestock and
wildlife water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
