PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61643 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Vance Means of 2275 Webster Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-4022, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and reservoir constructed under Permit R-5290 to be enlarged under Application R-58190, Permit R-8354, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of a reservoir for beautification; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 7, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet North and 650 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South Range 6 West, WM Section 24 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Beautification

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
