PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63066 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Maple Hill Cattle Ranch, by Deane S. Chappell, Owner, of PO Box 293, Scappoose, Oregon 97056, phone 543-2477, for the use of the waters of South Scappoose Creek, a tributary of Willamette Slough, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and stock use, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation and 0.001 cfs for stock use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 27, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.006 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 150 feet North and 1,570 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14; Diversion 2 - 1,100 feet North and 1,970 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, both being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 3 North, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North Range 2 West, WM Section 14 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.3 acre irrigation
and stock use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
