PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60607 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Micheel L. Anderson of 243 Southwest "1" - 1, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-9546, for the use of the waters of a spring and Good Time Gulch, tributaries of Grave Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from the gulch for domestic use, 0.063 cfs from the gulch for irrigation, and 0.05 cfs from the spring with any deficiency in the supply at the spring to be made up by diversion of water from the gulch for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 7, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.118 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 100 feet North and 50 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 4; Diversion 2 - 550 feet North and 320 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 4, both being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 34 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South Range 5 West, WM Section 4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 acres irrigation from the spring  
5.0 acres irrigation and domestic use for one family from Good Time Gulch

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
