PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61167 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert L. Burkle of 1036 Haynes Way, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-3759, for the use of the waters of Palouse Creek, Unnamed Creek "A" and Unnamed Creek "B", tributaries of Haynes Inlet, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each, being 0.08 cubic foot per second from Palouse Creek for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from Unnamed Creek "A" augmented by the use of water from Unnamed Creek "B" during summertime for domestic use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 17, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 460 feet North and 470 feet East from the N 1/16 Corner on the West line of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16; Diversion 2 - 754 feet West from the N 1/16 Corner on the West line of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16; Diversion 3 - 400 feet South and 950 feet West from the N 1/16 Corner on the West line of Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, all being within Township 24 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
