PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62174 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to B.W. Bixler and Janet Enos of 16555 North Applegate Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6143, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 10, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 28.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,230 feet South and 2,140 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM; Applegate Dam is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0407 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
