PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62336 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Richard L. Sharp of 741 West Jackson, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 773-8904, for the use of the waters of Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of temperature control and supplemental irrigation, being 1.5 cubic foot per second of water for temperature control and 0.125 cfs for supplemental irrigation provided the total diversion does not exceed 1.5 cfs; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 17, 1981 for 0.125 cfs and January 11, 1982 for 1.375 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 550 feet North and 870 feet West from the 5 1/4 Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 3 West, WM Section 28 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Temperature control and 10.0 acres supplemental irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
