PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61891 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tony Stanley of 688 South Calapooia Street, Sutherlin, Oregon 97479, phone 459-4160, for the use of the waters of Cooper Creek and Stanley Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-61890, Permit R-8370, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.2 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Cooper Creek) - 160 feet North and 220 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, and Diversion 2 (dam) - 40 feet South and 70 feet East, both from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, both being within Township 25 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year of stored water only, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
