PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62356 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank and Doris Elst of PO Box 136, Azalea, Oregon 97410, phone 837-3383, for the use of the waters of a spring, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families and irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.06 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from August 18, 1981 for 0.06 cfs and January 13, 1982 for 0.01 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.07 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,628 feet South and 1,060 feet West from the quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 14, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South	Range 5 West, WM	Section 14	SW 1/4	NW 1/4	Domestic use for one family
			SE 1/4	NW 1/4	Domestic use for two families and 5.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
