PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

"CERTIFICATE NO. 62529"

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62364 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ruth F. Jackson of 92643 Marcola Road, Marcola, Oregon 97454, phone 933-2665, for the use of the waters of Mohawk River, a tributary of McKenzie River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 21, 1961, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 500 feet North and 375 feet East from the Northeast Corner of Barton H. Allen DLC 39, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 16 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 16 South Range 1 West, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
