## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60243 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Walter S. Saunders, Jr. of Route 1, Box 21, Richland, Oregon 97870, phone 893-3275, for the use of the waters of an unnamed draw, a tributary of Eagle Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and power use for operation of a hydraulic ram, being 0.06 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.36 cfs for power use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 9, 1980 for irrigation and July 27, 1981 for power for ram, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.42 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 80 feet South and 290 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 14, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

			SE 1/4	NE 1/4	3.0 acres irrigation
			NE 1/4	NE 1/4	Hydraulic ram

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
