PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60714 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jack T. Norton, Jr. of PO Box 243, Dillard, Oregon 97432, phone 679-6529, for the use of the waters of West Willis Creek and five unnamed springs, tributaries of South Umpque River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, domestic use for one family, and stock, being 0.375 cubic foot per second of water from West Willis Creek for irrigation, 0.0025 cfs from Spring 1 for domestic use, 0.0025 cfs from Spring 2 for domestic use, and 0.003 cfs from Spring 3, 0.001 cfs from Spring 4, 0.001 cfs from Spring 5 for stock use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 18, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.385 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion I (West Willis Creen 1997) feet South and 4,430 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16; Diversion 2 (Spring 1) - 900 feet South and 620 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4; Diversion 3 (Spring 2) - 890 feet South and 700 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4; Diversion 4 (Spring 3) - 820 feet South and 780 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4; Diversion 5 (Spring 4) - 800 feet South and 870 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4; Diversion 6 (Spring 5) - 850 feet South and 1,980 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, all within Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South Range 6 West, WM Section 16 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one

family from Springs 1 and 2, 18.0 acres irrigation from West Willis Creek, and stock use from Springs

3 and 4

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 20.0 acres irrigation

from West Willis

Creek and stock use from

Spring 5

NW I/4 NW I/4 Stock use from Springs

3 and 4

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

APPLICATION 60714

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall therefore be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
