## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60989 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S.D.A. Illinois Valley Ranger District of Siskiyou National Forest of Highway 199, PO Box 389, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, phone 592-2166, for the use of the waters of unnamed stream, a tributary of Illinois River, for the PURPOSE of stock and wildlife use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 14, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,750 feet North and 2,150 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Renge 9 West, WM Section 13 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock and wildlife water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
