PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61910 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Sandra J. Fickes of 501 Caves Camp Road, Williams, Oregon 97544, phone 846-7101, for the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creek, a tributary of Williams Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 16, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 650 feet South and 2,270 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South Range 5 West, WM Section 8 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.5 acres
12.0 acres supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
